

## Roadrunner Meet & Greet Checklist

---

### Points to Cover During Interview

- Copy of Rules of Conduct and liability release. It is not necessary to obtain a signed copy at this time but the person(s) should be aware that the club requires this. Be sure to remind them that they will need to bring a government issued photo ID to their first event.
- Ask them what their experience has been with nude events and clubs? For instance, have they been nude at home, in public, or at spas, etc. If this is their first time see what questions and concerns they have.
- Find out what their expectations are concerning the Roadrunners Naturist Club.
- Be sure to ask them if they are married or have a significant other. Our current by-laws require both parties to join or if one doesn't want to then they have to sign a release. We require the signing spouse to attend at least once so we can meet/verify them.
- Let them know that after they have attended two events they can be asked to join by submitting an application.
- Let them know that as a guest they will be required to pay \$10, show ID, bring a towel to sit on, and will be required to sign a liability release. They do not need to bring a pot-luck dish since they pay an admission fee.
- Basically, you are "checking them out" on behalf of the club. Use your judgement, see if you think they would be a good fit for us. If you like them you can give them the information about the next event so the rest of us can meet them. If you don't like them or aren't sure just let them know you will get back to them and you can discuss the situation with the rest of the Board of Directors.
